- Plan on and off-ice activities in consultation with the assistant coach
- Coordinate player evaluation.
- Plan, implement and control pre-game preparation and communication with the team
- Design the practice plans in consultation with the assistant coach
- Coach the team in all games and practices
- Establish rules for the team and oversee the supervision of the players
- Submit a year end report which contains the following information – evaluation of players performance and recommendations on how the program can be improved.
- Report to the association through the Association convenor
- Strong hockey background in playing, coaching, evaluating
- Strong interest and commitment to child/athlete development
- Ability to work with fellow coaching personnel
- Ability to communicate on and off-ice requirements to players and parents
- Available to meet time requirements

Assistant Coach

COACHES FAIR PLAY CONTRACT

It is the intention of this pledge to promote fair play and respect for all participants within the NDG Minor Hockey Association. All coaches must sign this pledge before being allowed to participate in hockey and must continue to observe the principles of Fair Play.

FAIR PLAY CODE FOR COACHES

- 1 I will be reasonable when scheduling games and practices remembering that young athletes have other interests and obligations.
- 2 I will teach my athletes to play fairly and to respect the rules, officials, opponents and teammates.
- 3 I will ensure all athletes receive equal instruction, discipline, support and appropriate, fair playing time.
- 4 I will not ridicule or yell at my athletes for making mistakes or for performing poorly. I will remember that children play to have fun and must be encouraged to have confidence in themselves.
- 5 I will make sure that equipment and facilities are safe and match the athlete's ages and ability.
- 6 I will remember that children need a coach they can respect. I will be generous with praise and set a good example.
- 7 I will obtain proper training and continue to upgrade my coaching skills.

I agree to abide by the principles of the FAIR PLAY CODE as set by Hockey Canada and supported by the NDG Minor Hockey Association.
